TRIP SUMMARY & ITINERARY

DAYS 1 - 3

Travel to the US capital – Washington DC!

Head off for a guided tour of the US Capitol Building, and then visit the National Archives to see the Declaration of Independence, Constitution and Bill of Rights. Take a civil rights tour of downtown DC. This evening you will have a private moonlit tour of the monuments.

DISCOVER THE HISTORY OF ONE OF THE WORLD'S MOST INFLUENTIAL COUNTRIES

Learn about the history of news broadcasting by participating in an educational program at Newseum. Next pick a couple of museums from the amazing Smithsonian Institute.





DAYS 4 - 6

See the homes of both the US's first, and current presidents; George Washington's home at Mt Vernon and The White House.

Enjoy a guided tour of the historic Capitol taking your students on a journey through America's struggle to establish itself as a modern democracy.

IMMERSE YOUR STUDENTS IN THE HISTORY OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT WITH A WALKING TOUR OF HARLEM, NEW YORK

Tour the Pentagon in the morning and then transfer to New York City! Take in the views of 'the big apple' from the top of the Empire State Building.



DAYS 7 - 10

Visit the iconic Statue of Liberty, stopping in at the Ellis Island Immigration Museum. Then take in the 911 Memorial Museum before seeing how immigrant families lived a century ago in the Tenement Museum.
